- Use of phone relay service (when calling non-TTY users)

Captioned Phones (Phones with Written Words) and TTYs

NAME

FEATURES

Ultratec Uniphone 1140 TTY Phone



- Use as a phone or TTY
- Hearing Carry Over (HCO) calls (for people who can hear but cannot speak clearly)
- Voice Carry Over (VCO) calls (for people who cannot hear but can use their voice)
- Two-line text display
- Built-in flashing signal light
- Special keys for dialing, volume control, emergency, menu, and arrow keys
- Call progress indicator (says “ringing” or “busy”)
- Auto-answer takes messages for you when you are away

REQUIRES:

- Landline phone service (analog only, not digital)
- Use of phone relay service (when calling non-TTY users, or making HCO or VCO calls)
- Electrical outlet

FOR PEOPLE WITH:

- Severe hearing loss
- Normal hearing but cannot speak clearly—HCO
- The ability to use their voice but cannot hear—VCO

Other Phones

NAME

FEATURES

ActiVocal Vocally 3 Freedom Voice Dialer



- Connects between phone base and phone line
- Guided setup sequence with verbal prompts
- Pick up the handset and the phone will ask you what name to dial automatically
- Program up to 60 names and phone numbers into the dialer for voice recognition recall

REQUIRES:

- Landline phone

FOR PEOPLE WITH:

- Limited mobility
- Limited fine motor control

Other Phones

Reizen Big Button Speakerphone



- Big black and white contrast buttons for easier dialing
- Speakerphone with volume control (does not amplify sound)
- Hands-free answering
- Large, bright red flashing light signal

FOR PEOPLE WITH:

- Limited dexterity
- Permanent vision loss

Phone Signalers (Flashing and Vibrating Signalers)

ClearSound CR200 Ring Signaler



- Loud ringer adjusts up to 95 dB with various tone levels
- Connects directly to your telephone or phone line
- Bright LED light also flashes when the phone rings
- Table/wall convertible

Phone Signalers (Flashing and Vibrating Signalers)

Sonic Alert TR75VR Flashing Light Phone Signaler



- Plugs directly into the telephone line and a wall outlet
- Plug a lamp into the outlet on the device; lamp flashes to signal an incoming call
- Choice of three different flash patterns
- Press the button on the signaler to turn on the lamp (e.g. for reading)

REQUIRES:

- Electrical outlet
- Table lamp with power cord

- Severe hearing loss

Phone Signalers (Flashing and Vibrating Signalers)

MyAlert™ Telephone Pager Kit



- Wireless remote vibrating alert (extended range)
- Small receiver with visual indicators
- Three (3) alerts-extra loud (85 dB) sound, bright red flashing LED light, gentle yet powerful vibration
- Clips to belt or waistband

REQUIRES:

- Electrical outlet
- Two (2) AA batteries-not included

FOR PEOPLE:

- With severe hearing loss
- Who would NOT benefit from a flashing light or loud signaler
